Won a complex intra-family arbitration on behalf of an heir to a Greek shipping estate.


U.S. Versus Canada Treaty Arbitrations

Sweeping Victory Involving Collapsed Japanese Transaction

Won a sweeping victory for Sojitz Aerospace America Corporation in a complex arbitration brought by Goodrich Corporation over a collapsed transaction for the Japanese air force. A tribunal unanimously dismissed the claims and granted Sojitz's multi-million dollar counterclaim.

Rio Arbitration Victory Against Venezuela

Obtained a \$130 million award on behalf of a U.S. shipbuilding company against the Government of Venezuela in a contract dispute regarding the repair and refurbishment of two frigates.



A History of Excellence

More than 90 years in the forefront of arbitration

Hughes Hubbard was founded by Charles Evans Hughes, who went on to be the premier litigator of his day, a candidate for President in one of the closest elections in U.S. history, U.S. Secretary of State and Chief Justice of the United States.

In 1926, Hughes was appointed as a member of the Permanent Court of Arbitration at the Hague and in 1928 served as a U.S. delegate to the Pan American Conference on Conciliation and Arbitration.

Today, Hughes Hubbard arbitrators continue to act as leaders in major arbitral institutions. Our practice includes a former U.S. member of the ICSID panel of arbitrators who also served as chairman of the board and of the executive committee of the American Arbitration Association and is currently chair of the Law Committee of the AAA and a vice president of the Court of Arbitration of the LCIA. Our practice also includes a member of the executive committee of the Swedish Arbitration Association, a member of the ICC Task Force on Financial Institutions who is also chair of the Arbitration Committee of CPR and a former president of the Union Internationale des Avocats who has been active in the UIA's arbitration work.
