PetroChoice announced the deal on Nov. 10. Terms of the transaction were not disclosed. PetroLiance, based in Apex, North Carolina, will expand Pennsylvania-based PetroChoice's coverage of the Midwest and Southeast markets

The deal came on the heels of HHR's assisting PetroChoice in its acquisition of Tennessee-based lubricant distributor LubriCorp, which was announced on Oct. 1. HHR has also helped Greenbriar Equity Group-owned PetroChoice snap up a number of lubricant distributors in recent years, including Lorenz Lubricant Company, Suburban Oil and Craft Oil Corp.

The company distributes an extensive product offering of lubricants, coolants, metalworking fluids, equipment, auto-lube and filtration systems and contamination-control devices.
