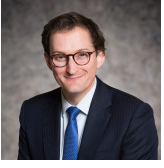
April 2020 — Jan Dunin-Wasowicz has been elected chair of the Anti-Corruption Law Interest Group (ACLIG) of the American Society of International Law (ASIL).

Dunin-Wasowicz previously served as vice chair since April 2017. His three-year term as chair began in March.
